


MIDDLE SCHOOL CURRICULUM




MIDDLE SCHOOL SUBJECTS AND CO-CURRICULARS



MAP TESTING

Measures of Academic Proficiency and Growth (MAP) is a computerized assessment that charts students' academic performance and growth over time. Students are tested twice yearly in math and reading to provide teachers with individual student and classroom testing data in support of planning and instruction to meet curricular and individual student goals. MAP tests also serve as an external reference point for our program by providing comparison data from the USA and other international schools.





The Color House program is designed to help nurture in our students a sense of community across grade levels. It uses a leadership model offering students the opportunity to strengthen our community and support each other. Through a strong advisory program, our students build on their strengths, develop self and social awareness and grow academically. With an eye on whole child development, our students participate in a range of activities from tackling hunger to taking care of their wellbeing.

LEARNING SUPPORT AND ENRICHMENT

RESPONSIBLE GLOBAL LEARNERS

We embrace everyone's voice, our unique differences and achievements, and service to others. In partnership with the local and global community, we gain an appreciation for unique issues, and gradually develop the skills and attitudes to help identify select social and environmental hurdles that require our attention and support.

LIFE AT ASH

Our school's home in Wassenaar, a peaceful village on the outskirts of Leiden and The Hague, provides an ideal background for learning, exploring and raising a family. Green and functional, our purpose-built campuses reflect the spirit of our extraordinary school. Our two locations are just a 6 minute walk apart from each other and 72 percent of our students ride their bikes to school along the safe bike paths in our community.

The middle school is located on our main campus where our students benefit from our state-of-the-art learning spaces, including:

ATHLETIC FACILITIES

Our middle school students have access to various multipurpose athletic fields, a newly-renovated sports hall, yoga space, and fitness center with the latest equipment.

PERFORMING ARTS CENTER

Middle school students host theatrical and musical performances in our purposely-designed space that seats 480 guests.

MIDDLE SCHOOL LIBRARY

Our spacious library helps students develop a lifelong love of reading, and become media-savvy, digital citizens. Students and their families can check out books and make use of all of our databases.

FOOD SCIENCE AND DESIGN LAB

Our modern classrooms invite hands-on experience and encourage collaboration. After all, we acknowledge that our students need to learn how to use a stove as well as a 3D printer.



STUDENT WELLBEING

We take the wellbeing of our students to heart and promote the emotional, social and academic growth of all learners. Our counseling team facilitates and guides our student wellness programs, ensuring that everyone learns in a safe, healthy, and supportive environment. The team is an important partner to our learners and strives to ensure their safety and comfort while at school. Our counselors also offer parent workshops and are available for parent consultations.

A SAFE HARBOUR

Because transitioning to a new school can be daunting, our counselors and student ambassadors support our students and their families during these milestone events, be it upon joining or leaving ASH. For more than 20 years, through our signature A Safe Harbour program, ASH has been curating a customized experience for our new students, families, and staff to help us transition and adapt to learning, working, and living in the Netherlands.

HOME-SCHOOL PARTNERSHIP

Parent-Teacher-student conferences and student-led conferences take place throughout the year to ensure that parents are part of their child's learning journey at ASH.

During Open Houses we share information about classes, schedules, and how we work as a school and division. During Parent coffees, we discuss middle school topics and value and promote this opportunity to gather and dialogue.

PARENT TEACHER ORGANIZATION (PTO)

The PTO is a volunteer organization that unites the school and our families in support of the success and well-being of our students. The PTO hosts various activities in the ASH community.

CHILDCARE

Daycare at ASH is located in the Early Childhood Center campus (ECC) and provided by an external but in-house provider, for children ages 0-3 years old.

We also offer after-school childcare for students ages 3 - 14 who are enrolled at ASH. Our service is available every day after school dismissal until 6.30pm.
